Applications are invited from qualified and interested candidates for the above-noted C.U.P.E. Local 115 (Inside) position in the Engineering and Infrastructure Department.

Reporting to the Supervisor of Engineering, the Civil Technologist will be required to complete pre-engineering surveys, construction layouts on sewer, road, watermain, sidewalks, other engineering projects carried out by the City and completion of preliminary and detailed design calculations/drawings for new and replacement infrastructure projects. The Civil Technologist provides technical assistance with the preparation of tender documents for various engineering projects. This position provides on-site inspection and oversight of City construction projects for road, sewer, watermain and sidewalks to ensure that the contract plans and specifications are adhered to during construction, and the quality of all work and material conforms to the contract specifications and standards, including material testing.

Essential (Minimum) Qualifications:

- A Civil Engineering Technologist post-secondary diploma and membership or eligibility for membership as a Certified Engineering Technologist with the Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists.
- One (1) year of experience in a similar position preferably in a municipal environment.
- Detailed knowledge and competency in computer applications in a windows environment, including Microsoft Office and Autodesk Civil 3D, AutoCAD and GIS.
- Exceptional interpersonal skills and communication skills (empathy, teamwork, positive attitude, an upbeat energy, professionalism and tact).
- Excellent organizational, time management and presentation skills are essential.
- A working knowledge of asset management would be an asset.
- A valid "G" class driver's license is required as is the ability to work outdoors in all types of weather.
