By-Law Number 003-2019

*A By-law to Amend City of Brockville By-law 060-2017
(Brockville Employment Lands - Report 2019-007-01 - File D09-07)*

WHEREAS the Council for the Corporation of the City of Brockville, on the 26th day of September, 2017, adopted City of Brockville By-law 060-2017, being a By-law to Adopt Amendment Number 005 to the 2012 Official Plan for the City of Brockville (Employment Lands); and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brockville deems it expedient to amend said By-law 060-2017;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BROCKVILLE HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Section 4.7.4.4.2 General Land Use Policies, Sub-section b., to be removed in its entirety and replaced with the following text:


"Section 4.7.4.4.2 General Land Use Policies,

"It shall be the policy of the City that:

b. Development within an Employment Area shall be compatible with adjacent residential uses and the zoning by-law will establish a range of uses that minimize potential land use conflicts and promote sound urban design."

2. THAT Schedule "B" to Official Plan Amendment 005 - Natural Heritage System, Open Space & constraints be removed and replaced with an amended Schedule "B" attached hereto as Attachment "A" to this By-law.

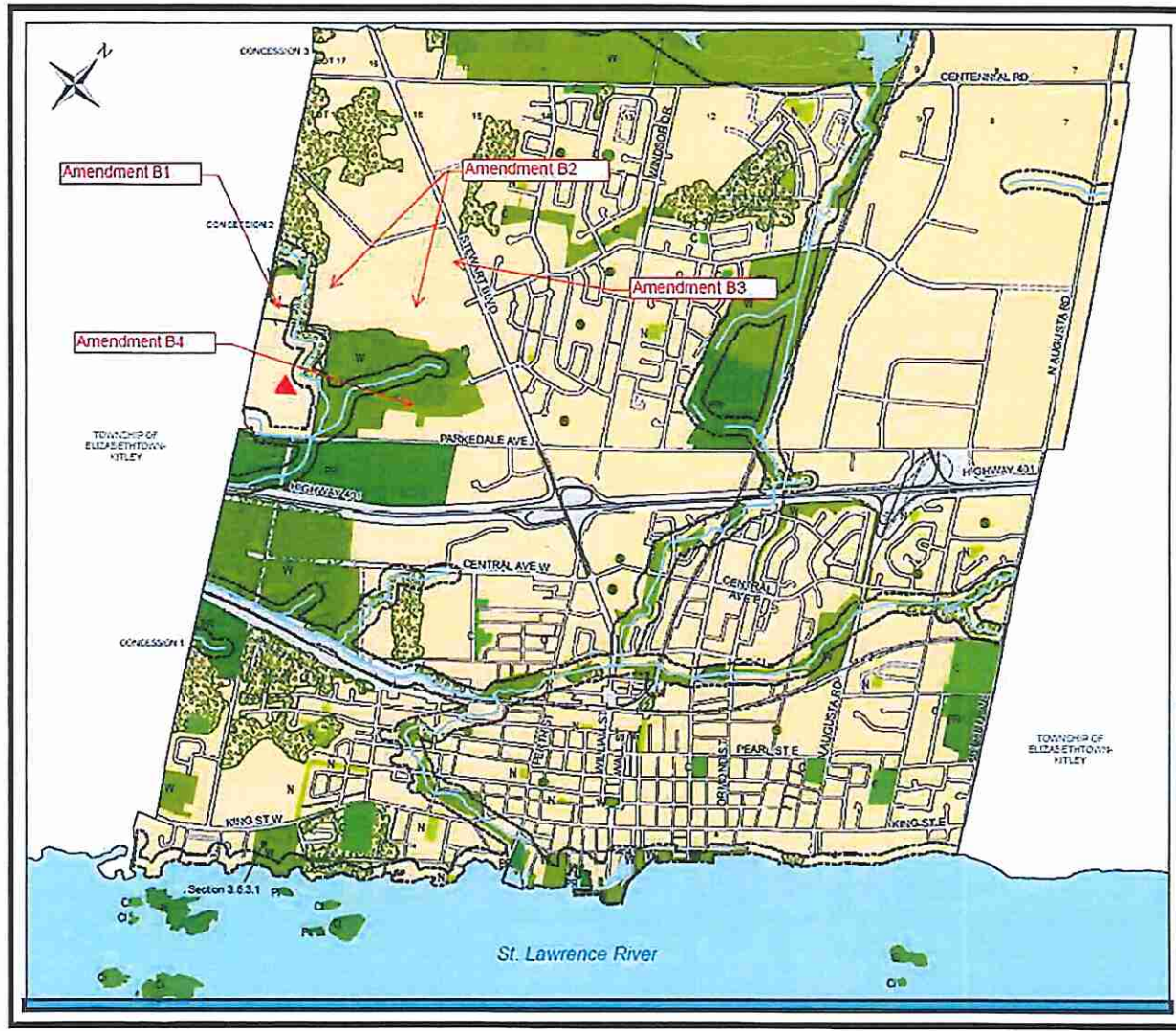
