CITY OF BROCKVILLE LEGACY FUND APPLICATION
Targeted to Funding Recreational and Cultural Capital Projects

The City’s Legacy Fund was established in 2009 with an allocation of \$200,000 from the City of Brockville into a fund under the management of the Brockville Community Foundation. Annual earnings from the invested funds, less a 2% management fee, are distributed to Brockville organizations. The fund has paid out a shared total of approx. \$8,000 each year.

The City of Brockville Legacy Committee consists of two members of Council and the three most recent Citizens of the Year. Qualifying projects will be determined by the five-person volunteer committee. The 2020 application process was postponed, so **this is a special year of \$16,000 in combined funds to be divided and distributed.**

This year’s deadline for applications is **Wednesday, March 31, 2021 at 4:00 pm.** Applications may be dropped off at **City Hall** (*If closed, there is a locked drop off box outside of City Hall 1 King St. just to the left of the main entrance doors*).
