### 2021 ISLAND CAMPING/DOCKING RULES

**\*\*\* Island Camping is subject to the Ontario COVID response framework \*\*\***

#### FEES

- Payable by going to [www.brockville.com/islands](http://www.brockville.com/islands) for online reservations and payment
- Day Use and Overnight Season Passes must always be visible to Islands Staff

#### NOISE

- Quiet time observed from 11:00 PM to dawn
- Only silent running generators (invertors) are permitted
- No fireworks permitted on park islands

#### ENVIRONMENT

- Do not disturb or feed wildlife
- Walk only on groomed trails and be mindful of ticks!
- Do not remove any natural or historic objects
- Hunting permitted by registered hunters on designated islands
- Do not collect downed trees/wood
- Fires permitted in fire boxes/pits/receptacles only. Do not leave fires unattended
- **All fires must be extinguished before leaving the site/location**
- Please use plastic or canned containers only

#### PETS

- Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times
- Pets must not disturb other visitors or island wildlife
- Owners must clean up after their pet and are responsible for any damage caused

#### DOCKING

- All Transient docks must be booked in advance
- Day Use Docking/Camping expires @ 8:00 PM - Overnight Docking/Camping expires @ 12:00 PM
- Maximum Stay: 3 consecutive nights on one island with no return for at least 3 consecutive days
- Tenders may not be used to reserve dock spaces or moorings
- Tenders may be moored on the side of your vessel, where possible, at no cost
- Beaching or docking fees are applicable to tenders if beached or using dock space
- Boats may not be left unattended overnight (from dusk to dawn)
- Camping fee includes docking for the registered camper's boat (one boat only)

#### CAMPING

- All Transient campsites must be booked in advance
- Camping is only available in designated areas and is NOT permitted on picnic islands
- Each camping site is allowed a maximum of two tents (eg. sleeping & dining)
- A campsite accommodates a maximum of six people or a single family unit (parents & their children)
- Maximum Stay: 7 nights and Overnight Camping expires @ 12:00 PM on the date of departure
- For Paddle In/Out sites, all canoes/kayaks/paddleboards must be beached or placed at campsite

**THE ISLANDS ARE REGULARLY PATROLLED BY CITY OF BROCKVILLE BY-LAW OFFICERS AND FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES MAY RESULT IN A MINIMUM 7-DAY SUSPENSION**
