City of Brockville Legacy Fund
Targeted to Funding Recreational and Cultural Capital Projects**

The Legacy Fund was established in 2009 with an allocation of \$200,000 from the City of Brockville into a fund under the management of the Brockville Community Foundation. Annual earnings from the invested funds, less a 2% management fee, are distributed in Brockville to organizations who apply for funding of recreational and cultural capital projects.

The City of Brockville Legacy Committee consists of two members of Council and the three most recent Citizens of the Year. Qualifying projects will be determined by the five-person volunteer committee. The 2020 application process was postponed, so **this is a special year of \$16,000** in combined funds to be divided and distributed.
