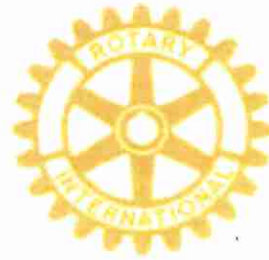


Rotary has planned, organized and executed the community city parade for the last 10 years with no request of additional city funding beyond the base of \$4000. We seek out and have received Corporate Support in kind, and other service club financial assistance. We estimate about 300 volunteer hours are dedicated to this event from our Clubs and Community volunteers.

Reference to Rotary's contribution to community, this is most significant as evidenced by the contributions from our fundraising of over \$500,000 in the past few years alone. Examples include our contributions to the Brockville Railway Tunnel, the Aquatarium, Rotary Park, Community Easter Egg Hunt, to name a small number of the local projects we support.


