

**ELECTION SIGN RESTRICTIONS**

**SIGN BY-LAW**  
**By-law No. 084-89**

*(Condensed copy for Election Candidates)*

SECTION 4 - PERMIT EXEMPTIONS

4.1. No permit under this By-law shall be required for:

- (a) any poster, banner, or sign of a candidate in a Municipal, Provincial, or Federal Election.

SECTION 5 - GENERAL REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL SIGNS IN ZONES

5.2 Except as otherwise provided for in this By-law, no person shall erect or maintain any sign which projects over any road allowance in the City of Brockville unless such sign is a fascia sign and that no portion of such sign shall project more than 0.45 metres (18 inches) over the road allowance or City property.

5.3 No person shall attach any sign, poster, hand bill, notice or advertisement to any pole or tree or any highway; or paint or impress anything on any sidewalk or roadway without permission to do so, by resolution of Council.

5.22 Removal of Signs

- (i) Election signs erected within the municipality must be removed within two days following the election.

**VISIBILITY TRIANGLES**

No election sign shall be placed within the corner visibility triangle at an intersection. The corner visibility triangle is the triangular area formed by the projection of the intersecting curb lines and a straight line connecting them 10 metres from their point of intersection. In simple terms, no roadside election sign can be placed within 10 metres of where the adjacent curb would intersect with the crossing street if the curb line continued straight.
