BOAT SLIP ALLOCATION

PURPOSE

To provide consistent, fair allocation of seasonal docking slips at the Municipal Harbour in Tunnel Bay.

PROCEDURE

1. The City shall maintain a total of 65 seasonal docking slips as follows:

Dock Section "A"

- 9 x seasonal slips for Power, Sail & Pontoon boats
- Power & Sail Boat LOA: up to 20'0", Maximum Beam: 9'0" **
- Pontoon Boat LOA: up to 25'0", Maximum Beam: 9'0" **

Dock Section "B"

- 32 x seasonal slips for Power & Sail boats and Personal Watercraft
- Boat LOA: 20'1" → 27'0", Maximum Beam: 8'6" **
- Length exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis at the sole discretion of the City

Dock Section "C"

- 19 x seasonal slips for Power & Sail boats and Personal Watercraft
- Includes one slip at the End of Dock Section "B"
- Boat LOA: 27'1" → 32'0", Maximum Beam: 10'6" **

Dock Section "Seawall"

- 4 x seasonal slips
- Boat LOA: 32'1" → 37'0", Maximum Beam: 10'6" **
- New boats must meet measurements above (existing boats are grandfathered in)

End of Dock Section "C"

- 1 seasonal slip
- Boat LOA: 37'1" → 48'0", Maximum Beam: 14'0" **

****** *The City requires all attachments and accessories (i.e. anchor, bow sprit, swim platform, hand rails, outboard motor, etc.) to be included when measuring bow to stern and port to starboard*

2. A completed Seasonal Docking Application form must be submitted for all seasonal docking requests.

3. If no slips are available, applicants will be added to the Seasonal Docking Waiting List based on the measurements of their boat (see Section 1). As appropriate slips become available, persons on the list will be contacted. Names remain on the Seasonal Docking Waiting list and roll over from year to year.
4. Seasonal slips will first be allocated to residents of and taxpayers to the City of Brockville.
5. Seasonal contracts are for one boating season, which runs from May 1 to October 15. Existing slip holders in good standing will be offered a slip the following year. The City of Brockville reserves the right to re-assign slips from year-to-year, at its sole discretion.
6. Those persons who presently have a seasonal docking slip but move out of the City of Brockville or no longer pay taxes to the City will be allowed to keep their slip.
7. Boaters who are residents of Brockville who presently have a seasonal docking slip and wish to relocate to another slip of the same size may do so by making their request in writing. Whenever possible, existing registrants will have priority on available slips over new applicants on the Seasonal Docking Waiting List. Changes in slips will be allocated based on the date the request was received and at the City's discretion if the City so deems appropriate.
8. Boaters who presently have a seasonal docking slip and wish to relocate to a slip on another dock will NOT be given preference over those persons already on the City's waiting list. Existing boaters must make their request in writing and identify their preferred dock based on the measurements of their boat (see Section 1). They will then be placed on the Seasonal Docking Waiting List according to the date the request is received and will be contacted when an appropriate slip becomes available.
