



Brockville Municipal Harbour
BOAT SLIP ALLOCATION PROCEDURE

PURPOSE:

Provide a consistent & fair allocation of seasonal mooring slips at the City's harbour facilities in Tunnel Bay.

PROCEDURE:

1. *The City shall maintain a total of 65 seasonal mooring slips as follows:*

- *Dock Section "A"*
9 seasonal slips for power, sail & pontoon boats
Power & sail boats up to LOA 20'0", maximum beam 9'
Pontoon boats up to LOA 25'0", maximum beam 9'0"
- *Dock Section "B"*
32 seasonal slips for power & sail boats and personal watercrafts
Boats LOA 20'1" → 27'0", maximum beam 8.5'.
Exceptions as to length may be made on a case by case basis at the sole discretion of the City
- *Dock Section "C"*
19 seasonal slips for power & sail boats and personal watercraft
Includes one slip at the End of Dock Section "B"
Boats LOA 27'1" → 32'0", maximum beam 10.5'
- *Dock Section "Seawall"*
4 seasonal slips
Boats 32'1" → 37'0", maximum beam 10.5'
Existing boats are grandfathered in. New boats must be 32'1" → 37'0"
- *End of Dock Section "C"*
1 seasonal slip
Boat LOA 37'1" → 48'0", maximum beam 14'

The City measures length overall (LOA) from bow to stern including swim platform and all attachments.

2. *Seasonal contracts are for one boating season. Existing boaters in good standing will be offered a slip the following year. The City of Brockville reserves the right to re-assign slips from year-to-year, at its sole discretion.*
3. *A completed Seasonal Docking Application form must be submitted to the Operations Department for all requests for seasonal mooring.*
4. *Seasonal slips will first be allocated to those persons who are residents of/or taxpayers in the City of Brockville.*
5. *Those persons who presently have a seasonal mooring slip and move out of the City of Brockville and no longer pay taxes to the City will be allowed to keep their existing mooring slip.*
6. *The City will continue to maintain a waiting list of Brockville residents requesting a seasonal boat slip. As slips become available, persons on the waiting list will be contacted based on the size of the available berth and its appropriateness for their boat (see above allocations). Inappropriate allocations will not be permitted.*

- 7. Boaters who are residents of Brockville who presently have a seasonal mooring slip and wish to relocate to another slip of the same size may do so by making their request in writing to the Operations Department. Whenever possible, existing registrants will have priority on available slips over new applicants on the waiting list. Changes in slips will be allocated based on the date the request was received and at the City's discretion, if the City so deems appropriate.*
- 8. Boaters who presently have a seasonal mooring slip but wish to change to a larger or smaller dock will NOT be given preference over those persons already on the City's waiting list. Existing boaters must make their request in writing identifying the dock required based on the size of their boat. They will be placed on the Department's seasonal waiting list according to the date the request is received and will be contacted when an appropriate slip becomes available for their boat.*
