The City of Brockville's Response to COVID-19

June 24, 2020 9:00 am - Transit Resumes Regular Services

On Monday June 29th at 7:00 am, Brockville Transit will be returning to the regular service schedule and 3-route system with the Red, Blue and Green routes active from 7am-6pm Mon-Fri and 9am-6pm on Saturday. The Yellow (Evening) Route will be active 6-9pm Mon-Fri. For more information about Brockville Transit Routes and Schedules click here <https://brockville.com/transit>

Please be advised that the City of Brockville is continuing to operate the Brockville Transit service with the following modifications in keeping with recommendations from our public health agency:

- Maximum of 8 riders on a bus at a time
- Hand sanitizer stations in each bus (at the front bus entrance)
- Enhanced cleaning protocols to ensure that all shared surfaces are disinfected daily
- Removal of certain ticket types to encourage social distancing.

The City would also like to remind and encourage everyone to follow the recommendations of our public health agency.

- Recommended that transit riders wear a mask or face covering during their travels
- Properly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Engage in proper cough or sneeze etiquette, including but not limited to covering your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze and disposing of used tissues immediately

- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth
- Refrain from shaking hands with another person
- Practice social distancing of at least 2 metres

City Council and staff continue to comply with [Stage Two](#) of Provincial openings and with the guidelines provided by the Province and the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit.

The Province recommends you get tested if you feel you are experiencing any symptoms of feel you have been exposed. The testing is free and available for walk-ins.

The City of Brockville continues to review the City services on a day to day basis while we take necessary precautions to stop the spread of COVID-19.
