

City of Brockville Islands  
**PARK ISLANDS AND CAMPING RULES**

**FEES**

- Payable upon arrival – see posted fee schedule at registration area
- Day Use and Overnight Season Passes must be displayed at all times

**NOISE**

- Quiet time observed from 11 p.m. to dawn
- Only silent running generators (invertors) permitted
- No fireworks permitted on park islands

**ENVIRONMENT**

- Do not disturb or feed wildlife
- Walk only on groomed trails – ticks may be present!
- Do not remove any natural or historic objects
- Hunting permitted by registered hunters on designated islands
- Do not collect downed trees/wood
- Fires permitted in fire boxes/pits/receptacles only. Do not leave fires unattended
- **Extinguish all fires before leaving island**
- Please use plastic or canned containers only

**PETS**

- Pets must be on a leash and under control at all times
- Pets must not disturb other visitors or island wildlife.
- Owners must clean up after their pet and are responsible for any damage caused

**DOCKING**

- Day use docking expires at 8 p.m. Overnight docking/camping expires at 12 noon
- Maximum stay is 3 consecutive nights on one island, minimum return time of 3 consecutive days
- Transient & camping docks are available on a first come basis
- Tenders may not be used to reserve dock spaces or moorings
- Tenders may be moored on the side of your vessel, where possible, at no cost
- Beaching or docking fees are applicable to tenders if beached or using dock space
- Boats may not be left unattended overnight (dusk to dawn)
- Camping fee includes docking for registered camper (one boat only)

**CAMPING**

- Is only available in designated areas. Camping is not permitted on picnic islands
- Each camping unit is allowed a maximum of two tents (eg. sleeping & dining)
- A campsite accommodates up to six people or a single family unit (parents & their children)
- Maximum stay 7 nights
- **PADDLE IN/OUT** sites - canoes/kayaks must be beached or placed at campsite

**ISLANDS ARE PATROLLED BY CITY OF BROCKVILLE BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**

**FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES MAY RESULT IN A  
MINIMUM 7 DAY ISLANDS SUSPENSION.**
