Reporting to the Director of Environmental Services, the Supervisor, Water Systems will be responsible for managing the efficient, safe, and compliant operation of the City's Water Treatment Plant and Water Distribution System. This position ensures the system is operating in compliance with applicable legislation and is the liaison with applicable Ministry officials as required.

Essential (Minimum) Qualifications:

- Two (2) year post-secondary diploma in Civil Engineering or environmental services field or related field of study. Equivalent combination of training and experience may be considered.
- Five (5) years' supervisory experience within a unionized environment in a comparable Water system.
- Valid province of Ontario Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MOECP) Class III Water Treatment and Class III Water Distribution Licenses.
- Thorough knowledge of all of the applicable legislation as it relates to a Class III Water Treatment and Distribution/Supply Subsystems.
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written, superior interpersonal skills and the ability to manage and motivate staff using effective team building skills.
- Experience with preparing and monitoring of annual operating and capital budgets.
- Strong knowledge of computers and software applications including Microsoft Office Suite, GIS and work order/work management systems.
- High degree of accuracy, attention to detail and record keeping skills.
- Problem-solving skills, discretion and good judgement when handling confidential/sensitive information and communicating with individuals regarding controversial matters; sensitivity and ability to maintain security of files.
- Comprehensive knowledge of the Safe Drinking Water Act, Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act, labor relations and collective agreements.
- Valid Ontario Class G Driver's License.
