Initiatives from 2025 Budget (cont'd for 2026)

- 4 new Special Constables with one assigned to each platoon
- 2 Recruit Police Constables by the end of 2025 putting 47 active police officers in the community (one is replacing a retirement)
- Downtown/Public Spaces Beat Initiative enhanced with the above personnel
- Duty Sergeant straight dayshift allowing Patrol Sergeants to patrol with their platoons
- 2 Mobile Crisis response/ Case Mgt teams in coordination with Brockville General Hospital and LLGMHA
- Expanded Third Party Criminal Records department
- Online Reporting
- NG911 Live / Expanded body cameras/ AI efficient reports system
